

These two friends, Savatore 18 years old and Pietro 22 years old came to America from Castelvetere Sul Calore outside of Naples Italy, on the SS Cedric leaving March 7, 1907 arriving March 17, 1907 in New York.

Nargi a stone mason, DeCola worked for the New York New Haven Hartford Railroad, raising their families next door to each other.

Fast forward 97 years later, DeCola's grandson marries Nargi's great granddaughter!

During World War II, Italian Americans were subject to restrictions and internment in the United States, including in New Haven, Connecticut:

Pasquale DeCicco: In the spring of 1942, federal officers took DeCicco, a U.S. citizen for over 30 years, from his home in New Haven to a detention center in Boston. He was then sent to Ellis Island.

INTERNMENT CAMPS: 418 Italian immigrants were held in internment centers.

RESTRICTIONS: Italian Americans were subject to:

- Curfews
- Unfounded searches and seizures
- Movement restrictions
- Registration at local post offices
- Fingerprinting
- Photography
- Carrying photo-bearing "enemy alien registration cards"
- Surrendering hand cameras, short-wave radio receiving sets, and radio transmitters
- Moving out of certain Exclusion Zones

The United States government has not yet apologized to the descendants of interred Italian Americans.


